Sentencings Come Close to Home

Last Thursday as most of us went on about our day as usual there were 4 people sentenced in the federal DC court. James Grant learned (after turning 30 in NNRJ and spending 3 birthdays incarcerated) he will soon be on his way home.

Among Grant's codefendants (although they do not know each other) is a Virginia resident by the name of Paul Russel Johnson who was sentenced to serve a year of weekends in jail, reporting at 5p.m. on Saturday and leaving Monday morning due to his wife suffering from a medical condition and them having children. This is something all judges do not take into consideration, but Judge Cobb seems to. Johnson will then have 2 years of home confinement, and this is all part of a 5-year probation sentence. While the fundraiser says it was needed by a certain date the link appears to be in operation, and I am sure the family still owes some legal fees.

Also among the codefendants are Steven Randolph of KY who was sentenced to 8 years in prison, Jason Blythe was sentenced to 2.5 years in prison. Ryan Samsel is also among the codefendants in this case and will be sentenced in February due to medical issues.

Living Death

All,

Tomorrow morning, a great thing is happening, one of our J6ers is heading to his half-way house, which likely means, by the end of the week he will begin the home confinement portion of his sentence. He has been in this facility for 13 months on 30-month sentence. I am so happy he is moving on, but as I have told him, I am so happy to see him leave, but sad to see him go.

Prison is a bonding experience for certain people, the J6ers have a special relationship, in many ways it's a brotherhood. It's not a gang, or any type of affiliation that pre-existed before that day. Rather, it's a shared experience caused by the common experience of prosecution in the same courthouse, often with the same prosecutors, and even sometimes the same judges. My experience is that we lift each other up, encourage each other, do our very best to keep every rule, even the little ones and generally practice kindness and attempt to uplift who we can. We all share the same prayer that this ends soon, that our experience isn't wasted, and that there is long-term meaning and purpose and collectively we can work to fix some of the issues we have seen with the Judicial, Jail and Prison systems. All that aside, there are times, it feels like a living death.

Matt DaSilva in DC first made this observation. When you are Incarcerated, you are separated from the outside world, you can get some news, and can communicate with select people, but in big way you are cut off. You can't manage your business affairs on the outside, you can't send instant messages, your calls are monitored, legally you are Civilly Dead. Your wives and children become prison widows and prison orphans.

Once inside, you start to develop routines, you are in a very controlled environment and start to get used to the people around you, sometimes you become very close to them. Then one day they leave. It doesn't matter why they leave, if they are transferred, go home, or sometimes even if they go to the SHU, they are gone. You will not ever hear from them again, till this all ends. They are not dead, but they may as well be, communication ends instantly, there is zero contact. They move on, and you stay behind. It's like a living death.

There is a certain amount of mourning, but our life will go on, as far in that we keep breathing, but it just won't be the same with our missing brother. While we are left in this hell, he will resurrect and go back to life.

May God bless him in his next chapter, I rejoice that his wife will have her husband back, and his children will have their father again.

Cynthia Price on Justice In Jeopardy

Cynthia Price (although her Facebook name, her maiden name, and the one the federal government charged her under, Cynthia Bellinger) appears on the latest episode of the Sovereign Souls podcast on Rumble (<https://rumble.com/v5ffppx-day-1350-justice-in-jeopardy-cynthia-price-reaction.-not-action..html>).

Cynthia speaks on her desire to go to DC on January 6th and how her husband had no desire to go, but what finally made him change his mind. She tells of what happened when they were in DC that day and what transpired after the day.

Cynthia and her husband (Christopher “John” Price) both received their sentence. Cynthia has served 4 months in a woman’s federal prison and speaks of her journey through the system. Did you know women are being incarcerated with men who identify as females? These men often share a cell with a woman. In a country that cares about its citizens why is no one talking about this?


Cynthia’s husband John is about to serve 45 days incarcerated. This is concerning as they have been on a journey of battling cancer and seem to have recently got his cancer under control again. The federal prison system does not facilitate a healthy environment needed to facilitate one’s health and that is a concern mentioned in the podcast. The difference in the time the husband and wife were sentenced to is also explained in the episode. You have a right to testify on your own behalf, but is it in your best interest?

Prison reform, justice reform, a love for Trump among the incarcerated due to the First Step Act (FSA), and how the First Step Act is helping, but still not understood by many who work in the system are all discussed also.

Toward the end of the episode, it is mentioned that one of the greatest things anyone can do is go to the Washington DC federal courthouse and show support for the defendants and be a witness as to what occurs in the courtrooms. This is important to know as MANY of the January 6th defendants are making their way to and through the appellate court system.

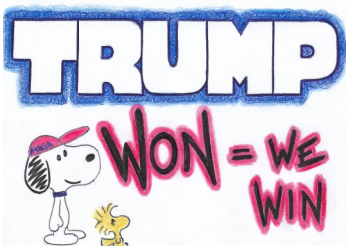
