All,

There is a phenomenon that happens in prison that I noticed right when I got here, now I understand it a little more. It is one of those plights a prisoner faces that he can't really avoidholes.

Walking around are inmates with holes in their shirts, holes in their shorts, holes in their underwear, holes in their socks, holes, and tears in just about everything. Fabric is sometimes nearly translucent. When I first got here, I just figured there was no reason to care about how you looked, maybe the faded, holy clothing was some sort of fashion statement, a badge of the years spent behind bars...Now I know better.

When I first got here, I was issued four pairs of tube socks with big seams in the toes (drives me nuts!), four brown undershirts, four oversize pairs of stick to your butt boxers and of course the Khaki Uniform. First thing is first, you need to buy new ankle socks, without the seams in the toes, shoes, some extra shirts to sleep in and work out in, some cotton fruit of the loom boxer briefs for \$12+, gym shorts for \$24. Now this time of year, sweats both tops and bottoms need to be purchased at nearly \$30 a pop. It's quite an investment, a shirt is nearly \$20. Socks are \$6+, they all add up, and that is before you get to shoes. A common thing is to buy used clothing in 'the yard' for stamps or cutting other deals for them. This is very sketchy, because I think technically it's a black market. Used shorts, shirts, even socks and underwear get passed around to arrivals just off the bus. When I arrived here, I got a pair of holey shorts and a massively oversized grey shirt, I was loaned a pair of shoes without insoles till my shoes from Philly arrived four weeks later. I bought underwear and socks at the first commissary opportunity.

Well now I have been in this location going on five months, and I am starting to see why so many inmates have holes. My shirts are getting holes, my socks ALL have holes in the toes and some the heels, even my underwear is coming apart at the seams. The shorts I got when I first arrived here have turned into Swiss cheese even further.

I think this is a phenomenon from washing everything twice a week in industrial washers with who knows how strong a detergent; the wearing of every article at least one day a week, constant walking and standing, it all contributes to the holes. I was putting on a pair of holey socks today, and realized, as of today, every single pair I have now has holes big enough for my whole big toe to slip through (something I detested at home), all my underwear has holes (I had to much dignity to be 'that guy'), and I looked down any my oversize grey shirt has a series of holes running down the front. It's not a badge of honor, it's not a sign of how much time you have spent here, because my brand-new socks and underwear de-


